
Biography of Stanley Wong Yuen-fai, SBS, JP

- Our club has made a donation of £2,000.00 to the Shelter Box, an international humanitarian agency, in response to the recent natural disasters. From Shelter Box on 22 Sept:
- "Over the last two weeks we've seen unprecedented extreme weather phenomenon like this bringing devastation all across the world.
- More than 1.7M people have been affected in Nepal, while a third of Bangladesh is under water. Huge areas of India and Myanmar are also in need of support. We already have a ShelterBox Response Team in Nepal assessing the damage, and another team arrived in Bangladesh on Friday. Still others are en route to Panama where we have 2000 ShelterKits prepositioned. Reports have just come through of an 8.1 magnitude earthquake off the coast of Mexico which has triggered Tsunami warnings. I can't imagine what all these people are living through right now, but I can imagine the relief and hope that your support will bring. Your amazing gift of £2,000.00 will help place the right tools and equipment in their hands to rekindle hope and ensure that they can begin the process of rebuilding their lives.
