In my last day as President I tried to review the past year before PE Emba took the helm in our great Club.

How was the year? The second time serving the club as president?

I think we all did well and lived the Theme of RI President John F Germ: Rotary – serving Humanity.

We achieved important RI goals, like an increase in our membership from 31 to 34 and since last Friday even 35.

And we were awarded with a special Recognition from the Rotary Foundation as The Highest all time contributing Rotary Club in District 3450 This has of course also to do with the generous donations from Past Presidents like Bill Benter. But it still counts and we can be proud.

Serving Humanity was the theme and that is what we did. I highlighted some of our signature Projects, helping and supporting needy people here in Hong Kong, in the asian region and globally.

- In our Community Service we go once a month and serve lunch at the FOOD ANGELS in Sham Shui Po to around 150 elderly .
- Vision Screening in October for the 12th year in a row in remote villages in China. Last time in Yunnan Province. With our Competence Team incl. Head Professors for Optometry, Post Graduate Students and Professional Optometrists and the ongoing support of our PP Maureen, the team went to 5 Schools and screened 841 Students. 384 of them needed Spectacles and received them a few weeks later. The generous support of HOYA lenses and Optometrists helped to get first class Spectacles to the Children, with a realistic market value of well over 400.000 HK\$







Vision Screening Trip October 2016 to remote Villages in Yunnan Province, China

We had a similar Vision Screening which PP Maureen coordinated for the elderly from the FOOD ANGELS. 102 Eldery from Sham Shui Po were screened, 35 received new spectacles and 28 needed treatment at Polyclinic.



In October we celebrated the HUB Charity Gala at Grand Hyatt Hotel. With over 450 guests an amount of 2.6 Million HK\$ was raised and will help to run and support the HUB and the Children in Sham Shui Po for the whole year. Now in the 4th year in Operation there are over 1450 Children and Teenagers registered and 735 of them participate in the various educational programs and activities throughout the week.

One fun example, where some of us joined was the Christmas Cookie Bakery with professional Chef Esther Roling.









Early December PP Bob coordinated 2 golf teams of our Club in support of the China Coast Community Chartity Golf-Day at Shek-O Country Club.

Together with around 70 other Golfers we helped to raise substantial funds for the needy elderly and enjoyed a great day.

Our Christmas Party at Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club was fun and entertaining as always. PP Ian as Santa Claus and PP Renee singing Intl. Christmas Songs made this evening unforgettable.
